

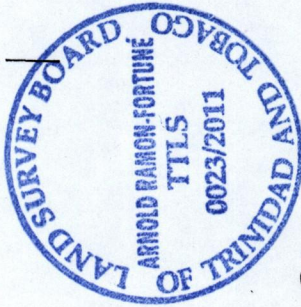
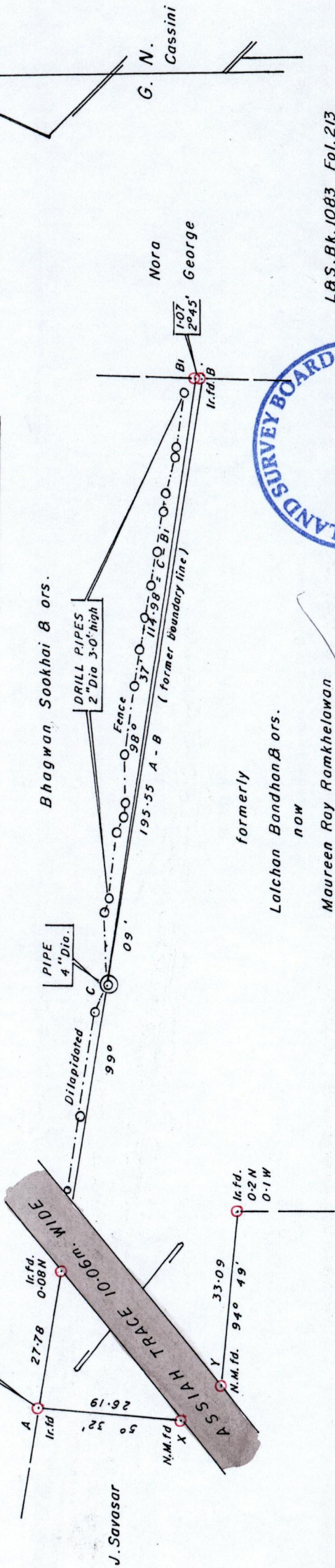

UPON this matter coming up for a Case Management Conference

AND UPON HEARING Attorney-at-Law for the Claimant and in person and Attorney-at-Law for the Defendant and in person.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY CONSENT that:

- The common boundary between the parties respective parcels of land described in their respective deeds do run from point A as shown on the survey plan of Arnold Ramon Fortune dated 29th day of August, 2011 in an Easterly direction at 99° 09' to a pipe on the said line referred to in the plan as a pipe 4 inches in diameter (referred to as 'C') and then to continue to run in an Easterly direction to a point 3.5 feet North of Point B as shown on the said plan (referred to as 'B1').
- The parties to submit to the Court on or before the 24th day of October, 2011 a revised survey plan by Arnold Ramon Fortune showing the common boundary described in paragraph 1 of this Order.

 3. PARTIES are at liberty to construct a fence on the common boundary between their respective parcels of land as shown on the said plan (referred to as 'B1'). The Defendant is at liberty to construct a fence on the common boundary consistent with the survey plan 'B1' to 'C'.
