ORDERING:

WHEREAS one Nathias McAuley (hereinafter referred to as the Grantee) then of the Island of Trinidad but now of the Island of Grenada, British West Indies, petitioned the Crown in writing on the Twenty-eight day of June in the year one thousand nine hundred and one for the parcel of land hereinafter described and paid to the Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands the sum of Ninety-five dollars and four cents in accordance with the Land Regulations dated the Twenty-seventh day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and Ninety-four AND WHEREAS the said lands were duly surveyed by William A. Cameron, Sworn Surveyor, in the month of November in the year one thousand nine hundred and one and the plan of survey was entered and approved by Charles Style Cochrane, the Engineer in charge of surveys in the month of November aforesaid AND WHEREAS the sale of the said parcel of land was completed in the same year one thousand nine hundred and one AND WHEREAS there was executed by Sir Alfred Maloney K.C.M.G., the then Governor
